The association addresses the reading deficit among schoolchildren in order to enable them to enter a successful (professional) life later on. We were able to transfer €400, and we are considering to giving away our children's books to the association.

Project: "Biological diversity in the Peruvian Amazon rainforest"

The background (as we reported) is the long-standing scientific cooperation between Prof. Eckhard W. Heymann (German Primate Center, Göttingen) and Prof. Birgit Ziegenhagen

(until 2019 University of Marburg).

With a further donation of approximately €800 to a non-governmental organization (NGO) in Peru, we were able to help secure their valuable work for the preservation of a small area of virgin forest

In the summer of 2025, copies of our children's book "Wie Monita zur Urwald-Superheldin wurde" were also sent to Peru. We had previously translated this book into Spanish. It brings our research on the "reforestation of primeval forest areas by small primates" to life for children.

Project: "Climate Forest"

A donation from I M u N e.V. helped to finance some of the small trees (deciduous species tolerant to summer drought) that were planted in 2023 on a depleted spruce area in the Marburg-Biedenkopf district (together with the Burgwald Forestry Office). Here is just a brief update. The forest is growing and thriving. We will probably offer a hike there in the spring of next year. We will announce this on our homepage.

Project "Media library – environmental and health knowledge"

Our media library is constantly growing with the help of association members and other supporters of I M u N e.V. We are extremely productive. The Pocket Series booklets are very popular.

What's new is that we now work with QR codes, which offer valuable additional knowledge in some booklets (more-knowledge QR codes). Take a look at the list of our booklets on the "Media" page of our website https://imun-ev.de/MEDIEN/.

An appropriate note: Our yoga booklet "Seven to Heaven" from the "PocketHealth" series has an additional breathing rhythm video (via QR code) to promote slower breathing and strengthen the vagus nerve. This video, as well as several others in other booklets, was edited by Mathias Moneke. Thank you very much!



Another new development is that we now offer several of our books in foreign languages. All of them have been translated by native speakers. Our children's book "Moníta - la superheroína de la selva" was translated by Dr. Bárbara Diez Rodriguez (Spain). Thank you very much!

Our three children's books "MiMu Loves the Sea," "Lala and the Water Paradise," and "Onyx and Xenia – two little dragons" have been available in English since 2025. Many thanks to Anna Roos (Switzerland) and Hannah Willis (USA)!

In addition, two books from our "PocketGallery" series have been published in English. The authors and editor translated the short texts themselves. This applies to the coral reef booklet ("Deep Dive") and the Amazonas booklet ("Breathtaking and endangered – Man and nature in the large floodplains of Brazil"). Both have additional informative QR codes and videos.

Although we offer a complete list of our books for download from our homepage, we would like to highlight one new publication in each of the two series PocketHealth and PocketKnowledge in our newsletters.

We are extremely pleased that a brand-new booklet (September 19, 2025) has now been added to the PocketHealth series: "Wie ich mein Gehirn fit mache und fit halte".

An equally brand-new (September 19, 2025) and informative booklet from the PocketWissen series will delight and amaze you: "Streuobst – Dem Apfel auf der Spur"

3. Networking and upcoming activities

Cooperation with the Deutsches Meeresmuseum (DMM) and the Förderverein des Deutschen Meeresmuseums (FDM)

DMM means "Ocean Museum Germany" and FDM an association in support of the DMM

At the end of March, Birgit Ziegenhagen and Thomas Heintze visited Stralsund to expand our existing cooperation and develop detailed concepts. Not only did they visit the extremely impressive exhibitions, but they also spoke with DMM's and FDM's board members about jointly distributing their booklets on environmental knowledge and about joint marine conservation issues (e.g., seagrass and coral reef restoration). Specifically, the projects will be able to begin at the end of this year at the earliest. A big thank you to Prof. Dr. Burkard Baschek (DMM), Dr. Harald Benke (formerly DMM) and Matthias Wolters and Anica Rothbart-Nickel (both FDM). We will report back in due course.

Cooperation with the National Park Kellerwald-Edersee

This cooperation project was also discussed further in a Zoom meeting with the park's management. In the medium term, there are plans to develop ONE HEALTH projects between the city of Bad Wildungen and the National Park.

Cooperation with other initiatives

- We are working together with the "Lebensmittelzentrum LMP Wehrda (Wehrda Food Center)" and the "Marburg Food Council" (see above).
- We are working with the Mushroom Museum and the Bad Laasphe Mushroom Association to distribute the joint mushroom booklet.

 Common concern: "Waste in the landscape, waste in the ocean".

Cooperation with universities

University knowledge should be made accessible to everyone. To this end, I M u N e.V. would like to contribute with a campaign that has just been launched: "RaUReiW – From university, out into the world." The aim is to promote science communication, particularly in the environmental sciences.

Exhibition plans: At the end of September/beginning of October, I M u N e.V. will be represented with a book table at a medical congress. Our thanks go to the hosts and organizers.

New booklets: New booklets are in the pipeline. A booklet about peat bogs as important CO₂-binding systems, impressive habitats and severely endangered ecosystems is expected to be published in 2026.
